ORDER OF COMMITMENT
UNDER CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ARTICLE, TITLE 3-106 (b)

The defendant having been charged with the commission of a crime and having been found incompetent to stand trial, and having been found by reason of a mental disorder to be a danger to self or the person or property of another, it is this _____ day of _____, 2015 by District Court of Maryland for Montgomery County:

ORDERED that the defendant be and hereby is committed to the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (Health Department) under Title §3-106(b) of the Criminal Procedure Article for confinement and treatment until such time as the Court is satisfied that the defendant is no longer incompetent to stand trial or is no longer by reason of a mental disorder a danger to self or the person or property of another.
