A student went to the health room to report that he was bitten on the cheek by a dog when he arrived at school in the morning on Monday, March 9. He said it occurred at the front entrance to the school. The student's parent was notified immediately. The dog was mainly brown but also had other colors on his fur which were black and white and it wore a pink and brown collar.

A dog bite requires follow-up medical attention, therefore it is important to determine if anyone witnessed this incident. If you have any information that may be helpful or if you are the owner of the dog, please contact my office at 301-840-7161.
