Dear Parents, Guardians and Staff:

It is with great sadness that I inform you of the death of Ms. Anika Browne, special education teacher at the Blair G. Ewing Center. Details around her passing have been reported by the Prince George's Police Department and through various news outlets.

Ms. Browne was a valued staff member who loved interacting with students. She cared deeply about the children and staff with whom she worked. Ms. Browne was firm, yet loving as she worked to ensure the safety and well-being of her students. She greeted staff and students with a smile and always had a secret stash of goodies to keep everyone motivated.

We recognize that students may be affected by her death. Supports will be made available to all students and staff by the school's Student Support Team. Students will have the opportunity to discuss and process their feelings; however, participation in these activities is voluntary. Staff will be available as needed to help students process their emotions.

At home, please pay close to attention to your child's emotional needs during the next few weeks, particularly if your child was close to Ms. Browne.

- Make yourself available for your child and encourage them to discuss their feelings.
- Look for signs of distress, such as: irritability, anger, difficulty focusing, and regression (bed wetting, nightmares).
- While it is normal and expected to experience grief, take note and intervene if these responses are prolonged or extreme. Watch for signs of ongoing difficulty, such as prolonged sadness, withdrawal, or changes in eating or sleeping habits.
- Watch for any behaviors that are unusual for your child.
- These signs may indicate that your child needs additional supports.
